

# Guardian Conference Attendee Packing List

- Clothing: Be prepared for hot sunny days.
- Rain Gear (Optional)
- Closed toed shoes
- Sunscreen and plenty of it
- ChapStick
- Personal Hygiene Kit
- Water bottle
- Prescriptions and Medications
- Travel First Aid Kit & Trauma Kit



## Range Specific Gear

- Primary Handgun
- Secondary Handgun (Optional)
- Shotgun and/or Carbine (Depending on your class schedule)
- A minimum of 3 magazines for each firearm
- An appropriate holster for each firearm (No Serpa. No soft/collapsible.)
- A proper gun/concealed carry belt
- Magazine carrier for each firearm is recommended (You should be able to carry at least 2 spare mags on your person)
- Electronic hearing protection
- Safety glasses (Safety-rated wrap-around glasses. Traditional prescription glasses will not meet the standard)
- \*Minimum 800 rounds of ammunition

Optional Items to consider: Extra batteries for Red Dot, Shooting gloves, Note taking materials, Camp chair, Maglula Uplula or other mag loader, Cleaning kit and lubricant, Knee pads

\*Please review [the class descriptions for each class](#) you will be attending as some require specific gear which may not be included in the above list. Your required round count will vary both based on which blocks of instruction you attend but also based on how you choose to conserve ammunition while shooting. As an estimate, most attendees will use between 300 and 800 rounds of ammunition. We recommend erroring on the side of caution and bringing 800 rounds.
